STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to abolish the Police Court for the City of Rockland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 114 of the Public Laws of 1903, and all acts
2 additional thereto and amendatory thereof, establishing the
3 police court for the city of Rockland, are hereby repealed.
