### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE. HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section one of Chapter eighty-two of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninetyone, relating to the supplying of the city of Auburn with pure water.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of Chapter eighty-two of the Private and

- 2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-one is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "laundries" in the
- 4 eighth line thereof the following words, 'for operating
- 5 motors used to run family washing machines,' so that said
- 6 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The city of Auburn, or the trustee herein2 after provided for, or any corporation of which either may
3 obtain control, as provided in Section two, either directly or
4 through ownership of stock, are authorized and empowered
5 to take water from the Androscoggin river, Wilson pond,
6 Taylor pond, and any other pond or spring in the city of
7 Auburn, sufficient for domestic purposes in said city, in8 cluding a sufficient quantity for extinguishing fires and the
9 supply of hotels, livery stables and laundries, for operating
10 motors used to run family washing machines, and for
11 sprinkling streets within said city; and for the purposes
12 aforesaid, to take and convey through the city of Auburn,
13 and to all parts thereof, any of the waters aforesaid, by
14 aqueduct or pipe sunk to any depth desirable for said pur15 purposes.'
