STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to railroad tracks crossing Congress street near the Union Station in Portland for the better protection of the public.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Portland Terminal Company shall on or before Jan2 uary 1, 1919, cause all rails and tracks now crossing Con3 gress street near the Union Station in the city of Portland
4 to be elevated so as to allow an under-pass for travel over
5 Congress street.
