IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize Oxford Electric Company to extend its electrical lines to and within the town of Hebron, and to purchase the electrical equipment and franchises of Trustees of Hebron Academy.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Subject to the provisions of the public laws 2 of the state, Oxford Electric Company, a corporation duly 3 established by law at Norway, in the county of Oxford, is 4 hereby authorized to extend its lines of poles, wires and 5 fixtures to any point or points within the town of Hebron, 6 in the county of Oxford, and to sell and supply electricity

7 for lighting streets and buildings, and for heating, manu-  
8 facturing and mechanical purposes within said town of He-  
9 bron; and to make contracts for supplying electricity for  
10 the purposes aforesaid with persons and corporations with-  
11 in said town of Hebron, and said town of Hebron is au-  
12 thorized to contract with said Oxford Electric Company  
13 for lighting the streets and public buildings of said town.

Sect. 2. Oxford Electric Company is hereby authorized  
2 to purchase upon such terms as may be agreed upon, the  
3 lines of poles, and wires and fixtures thereon and all elec-  
4 trical equipment of the Trustees of Hebron Academy, lo-  
5 cated in Mechanic Falls, in the county of Androscoggin  
6 and in Hebron, in the county of Oxford, and all locations,  
7 rights, privileges and franchises, possessed and enjoyed by  
8 the Trustees of Hebron Academy to sell and supply elec-  
9 tricity within the town of Hebron. Said purchase shall be  
10 subject to the approval of the Public Utilities Commission,  
11 and upon such purchase Oxford Electric Company shall  
12 have, hold, possess, exercise and enjoy all the locations,  
13 powers, privileges, rights and franchises for selling and  
14 supplying electricity within the town of Hebron, then held,  
15 possessed and enjoyed by the Trustees of Hebron Academy,  
16 and without limiting the generality of the foregoing grant,  
17 all rights, privileges and franchises granted to the Trustees  
18 of Hebron Academy by chapter two hundred and five of  
19 the Private and Special Laws of Maine for the year nine-  
20 teen hundred and three.

Sect. 3. The location of all poles, wires and fixtures of  
2 said Trustees of Hebron Academy, for transmitting and  
3 distributing electricity, as now established and maintained,  
4 are hereby confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 4. Oxford Electric Company shall not exercise any  
2 right or authority hereunder to extend its electrical lines  
3 into or in the town of Hebron, until it has made a contract  
4 with the Trustees of Hebron Academy for the purchase  
5 of the transmission lines and equipment, and electrical  
6 franchises, of the Trustees of Hebron Academy, which said  
7 Trustees are authorized to sell under the provisions of  
8 chapter two hundred and five of the Private and Special  
9 Laws for the year nineteen hundred and three, which pur-  
10 chase shall be subject to the approval of the Public Utilities  
11 Commission as provided in section three hereof.
