AN ACT to amend Section 25 of Chapter 30 of the Revised  
Statutes, relating to inspector of buildings.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 25 of Chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the word "appoint" in the fourth  
3 line of said section and inserting in place thereof the word  
4 'elect' so that said section, as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 25. In every town and city of more than two thou-  
2 sand inhabitants, and in every town of two thousand inhab-  
3 itants or less if such town shall so vote at an annual town

4 meeting, the municipal officers shall annually in the month  
5 of April elect an inspector of buildings, who shall be a man  
6 skilled in the construction of buildings, and shall determine  
7 his compensation. The municipal officers shall define the  
8 limits within which the inspector of buildings shall have  
9 jurisdiction, which shall include the thickly settled portion  
10 of each such city, or of each village in each such city or  
11 town.'
