IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 38 of Chapter 40 of the Revised
Statutes of 1916, Relative to Old Home Week.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 38 of Chapter 40 of the Revised Statutes of 1916,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "year" in
3 the second line thereof, the following words, 'or any week
4 a town may designate at its annual town meeting,' so that
5 said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 38. The week commencing with the second Sunday
2 in August of each year, or any week a town may designate,
3 at its annual town meeting, is hereby designated and set
4 apart as Old Home Week.
