#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Establish the Wages of Clerks in the Offices of Aroostook Register of Deeds, Southern District, and Clerk of Courts of Aroostook County and to secure to such Clerk of Courts reimbursement for necessary expenses in attendance at the terms of the Supreme Judicial Court held at Caribou.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred seventeen of 2 the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred sixteen is amended 3 in the third paragraph thereof so as to read as follows:

'In Aroostook county; for clerks in the office of register

2 of deeds of the northern district, five hundred dollars; for 3 clerks in the office of register of deeds in the southern dis-4 trict, one thousand seven hundred dollars; for clerks in the 5 office of register of probate, six hundred twenty-four dol-6 lars; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, one thousand 7 eight hundred dollars, and expenses of the clerk of courts 8 and his subordinates while attending the sessions of the 9 supreme judicial court at Caribou, to be allowed by the 10 court.'
