STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of the State Tuberculosis Sanatoriums for
maintenance and other purposes for the years nineteen hun-
dred seventeen and nineteen hundred eighteen.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated:

FOR THE CENTRAL MAINE SANATORIUM

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages of all
2 officers and employees except those wholly engaged in repairs
3 of buildings and equipment, for the year nineteen hundred
4 seventeen, the sum of eight thousand five hundred
5 (\$8,500.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred
6 eighteen, the sum of eleven thousand four hundred (\$11,-
7 400.00) dollars.

For food supplies, namely, all articles of food, for the year
2 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of nine thousand five
3 hundred (\$9,500.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hun-
4 dred eighteen, the sum of twenty-eight thousand (\$28,000.00)
5 dollars.

For repairs and equipment, namely, all materials and sup-
2 plies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached
3 fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replacements of fur-
4 niture and equipment, including farm equipment and live-
5 stock, and all personal services rendered wholly in connection
6 with repair work, for the year nineteen hundred seventeen,
7 the sum of two thousand nine hundred (\$2,900.00) dollars,
8 and for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of seven
9 thousand (\$7,000.00) dollars.

For general expenses, namely, all other materials, supplies
2 and expenses incident to maintenance of the institution and
3 the patients thereof, whether present or absent, including fif-
4 teen hundred dollars for the care and treatment at the Bangor
5 Anti-Tuberculosis Sanatorium of patients eligible for care at
6 said Central Sanatorium, for whom there are not sufficient or
7 suitable accommodations, for the year nineteen hundred sev-
8 enteen, the sum of seven thousand one hundred (\$7,100.00)
9 dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, including
10 fifteen hundred dollars as previously specified, the sum of
11 seventeen thousand one hundred (\$17,100.00) dollars.

For remodeling Chase building, so-called, for the year nine-
2 teen hundred eighteen, the sum of seven thousand five hun-

3 dred (\$7,500.00) dollars. (This building to be hereafter
4 known and designated as the Chase Memorial Building.)

For equipment of said remodeled Chase building for the
2 year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of seven thousand
3 (\$7,000.00) dollars.

For sewerage system and water main for the year nineteen
2 hundred seventeen, the sum of six thousand (\$6,000.00)
3 dollars.

For the construction of two new pavilions, for the year nine-
2 ten hundred seventeen, the sum of twenty thousand (\$20,-
3 000.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred eighteen,
4 the sum of twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) dollars.

FOR THE WESTERN MAINE SANATORIUM.

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages of all
2 officers and employees except those wholly engaged in repairs
3 of buildings and equipment, for the year nineteen hundred
4 seventeen, the sum of twenty-four thousand three hundred
5 (\$24,300.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred
6 eighteen, the sum of twenty-four thousand three hundred
7 (\$24,300.00) dollars.

For food supplies, namely, all articles of food, for the year
2 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of twenty-six thousand
3 six hundred (\$26,600.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen
4 hundred eighteen, the sum of twenty-six thousand six hun-
5 dred (\$26,600.00) dollars.

For repairs and equipment, namely, all materials and sup-
2 plies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached

3 fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replacements of fur-
4 niture and equipment, including farm equipment and live-
5 stock, and all personal services rendered wholly in connec-
6 tion with repair work, for the year nineteen hundred seven-
7 teen, the sum of eight thousand six hundred (\$8,600.00) dol-
8 lars, and for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of
9 eight thousand six hundred (\$8,600.00) dollars.

For general expenses, namely, all other materials, supplies
2 and expenses incident to maintenance of the institution and
3 the patients thereof, whether present or absent, for the year
4 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of eighteen thousand
5 eight hundred and twenty-five (\$18,825.00), and for the year
6 nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of eighteen thousand
7 eight hundred and twenty-five (\$18,825.00) dollars.

For construction of sewerage system, for the year nineteen
2 hundred seventeen, the sum of two thousand five hundred
3 (\$2,500.00) dollars.

For the construction of poultry houses, for the year nine-
2 teen hundred seventeen, the sum of one thousand
3 (\$1,000.00) dollars.

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropriated
2 for the year nineteen hundred seventeen which may remain
3 unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for ex-
4 penditure during the year nineteen hundred eighteen, and
5 provided further that the expenditure of all of the sums
6 above appropriated by, or under the control of, the trustees
7 of said sanatoriums, shall be subject to the direction and

8 approval of the Governor and Council, who may, by order,
9 upon recommendation of the said trustees, authorize the use
10 of unexpended balances of any of the above appropriations
11 to meet deficiencies for the same institution.
