STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of Addie L. Coombs, of Montville, for
state pension.

Resolved: That there be paid to Addie L. Coombs of
2 Montville, the sum of eight dollars per month, payable quar-
3 terly, from the funds appropriated for military pensions, be-
4 ginning January first, nineteen hundred seventeen, and con-
5 tinuing during the pleasure of the Legislature and until
6 otherwise ordered.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Miss Addie L. Coombs is the daughter of William Coombs, who served as a private in Company G, 28th Regiment. She is in poor health, and is now 55 years of age, with no income only what she is able to earn, which is not enough to keep her. She has no relatives who are able to provide for her and unless she can be granted a state pension it looks as though she would become a town charge.
