RESOLVE Providing a State Pension for Flora Stevens, of
Lewiston.

Resolved, That the sum of eight dollars per month, be
2 paid to Flora Stevens of Lewiston, widow of Wm. W.
3 Stevens, who served in Company D, Maine Coast Guards,
4 payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military
5 pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred and
6 seventeen, and continuing during the pleasure of the Legis-
7 lature and until otherwise ordered.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mrs. Flora Stevens, now residing at No. 292 Lincoln Street, Lewiston, County of Androscoggin, State of Maine, widow of Wm. W. Stevens, who served in Co. D, Maine Coast Guards. He was drawing a small U. S. pension of \$15.00 at the time of his death, November 10th, 1915. She cared for him to the last in his long sickness and worked out some to keep him from calling for outside aid. He had no property. She does not draw any U. S. pension and is dependent on what little she can earn for her living. She is now 65 years of age, is honorable and deserving.
