STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to ratify, confirm and make valid the proceedings of the special town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Baileyville held April 17, 1916, and the bonds issued by said town at said meeting for the purpose of erecting a schoolhouse in said town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All the proceedings of the special town meeting of the inhabitants of the town of Baileyville held April 17, 1916, including the votes passed at said meeting to raise by loan twenty thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting and equipping a school building in said town, and to

6 issue bonds of said town to provide for the payment of
7 such loan, are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 2. The five per cent bonds to the amount of twenty
2 thousand dollars dated February 1, 1916, and payable one
3 thousand dollars thereof on the first of February in each
4 of the years 1921 to 1940 inclusive, for the purpose of
5 erecting and equipping a school building in said town of
6 Baileyville, pursuant to the votes passed at said special
7 town meeting, are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.
