STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT Section forty, Chapter sixteen, Revised Statutes, in relation to appointment of school physicians and repealing Section forty-eight of said Chapter sixteen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty of Chapter sixteen of the Re-

- 2 vised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words
- 3 "one thousand" in the fourth line of said section and insert-
- 4 ing in place thereof the words 'two thousand,' so that said
- 5 section as amended shall read as follows:
 - 'Sect. 40. The superintending school committee of every

- 2 city and town shall appoint one or more school physicians
- 3 and shall assign one to the medical inspection of not over
- 4 two thousand pupils of the public schools within its city or
- 5 town, and shall provide them with all proper facilities for
- 6 the performance of their duties as hereinafter prescribed;
- 7 provided, however, that the said committee has been so au-
- 8 thorized by vote of the town at a regular town meeting or at
- 9 a special town meeting called for that purpose.'
- Sect. 2. Section forty-eight of Chapter sixteen of the 2 Revised Statutes is hereby repealed.
