AN ACT Additional to Chapter 51 of the Private and Special  
Laws of 1907, Relating to the Pollution of the Waters of  
North or Varnum's Pond.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

If any person shall bathe in the waters of said North or  
2 Varnum's Pond so long as the waters of the same are used  
3 for the purpose of supplying the water for domestic use,  
4 in any town or village, he shall be fined not exceeding twenty  
5 dollars, or imprisoned not exceeding six months.
