STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section twenty-eight of chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes relating to registration of vital statistics.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section twenty-eight of chapter sixty-four of the re-2 vised statutes be amended by adding after the word "burial"

- 3 in the eighth line thereof the words 'or whenever the de-
- 4 ceased person was born in any other town of this state' and
- 5 by inserting after the word "burial" in the eleventh line
- 6 thereof the words 'or in which said deceased person was
- 7 born as aforesaid' so that said section as amended shall read
- 8 as follows:

'Sect. 28. Clerk shall make certified copy of record on 2 first Monday of each month and transmit to clerk of town 3 where person or parent of child were resident at time of 4 death. R. S. c. 61, Sec. 27. The clerk of each town shall 5 on the first Monday of each month make a certified copy 6 of the record of all deaths and births recorded in the books 7 of said town during the previous month, whenever the de-8 ceased person or the parents of the child born were resident 9 in any other town in this state, at the time of said death, 10 or birth, or whenever they were recently resident in any 11 other town, or whenever the remains of any deceased per-12 son have been carried to any other town for burial or when-13 ever the deceased person was born in any other town of 14 this state, and shall transmit said certified copy to the clerk 15 of the town in which said deceased person or parents were 16 resident at or near the time of said birth or death or to which 17 the remains of such deceased person have been carried for 18 burial, or in which said deceased person was born as afore-19 said, stating in addition the name of the street and the num-20 ber of the house, if any, where such deceased person or 21 parent so resided whenever the same can be ascertained; 22 and the clerk so receiving such certified copy shall record 23 the same in the books kept for recording deaths or births. 24 Such certified copies shall be made upon blanks to be fur-25 nished for that purpose for the registrar of vital statistics.'
