STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT Providing for Court Jurisdiction in Criminal Cases
originating in Hibberts Gore.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The constables and health officers of the town
2 of Palermo, in the county of Waldo, and State of Maine,
3 are hereby empowered to act within the limits or confines
4 of Hibberts Gore with the same powers and limitations that
5 they now have, or that may hereafter be given to them, to
6 act in the said town of Palermo.

Sect. 2. The fish and game wardens and their deputies are
2 hereby empowered to enforce the fish and game laws of the

3 state within the limits or confines of said Hibberts Gore.

Sect. 3. The courts of Waldo county are hereby given
2 jurisdiction over criminal acts committed in said Hibberts
3 Gore, and the sheriff of said county and his deputies are
4 empowered to make arrests and serve process in said Hib-
5 berts Gore.

Sect. 4. If the town of Palermo or the county of Waldo
2 incur any expense under the provisions of this act, they
3 shall be re-imbursed from the treasury of the state from any
4 unexpended fund or appropriation, as the governor and
5 council shall direct.
