STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize and direct the county commissioners of Aroostook county to enlarge and repair the court house at Houlton in said county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county commissioners of Aroostook county are hereby
2 authorized and directed to proceed forthwith to expend so
3 much as shall be needed, not to exceed in all the sum of
4 sixty-five thousand dollars in enlarging and repairing the
5 court house in Houlton in said county, and rebuilding therein
6 the fire proof vaults for the offices of clerk of courts, the

7 register of probate and the register of deeds, enlarging and
8 remodeling the various rooms and apartments, and to obtain
9 a loan or loans for such purposes and for said amount, and
10 cause notes or obligations of said county with coupons for
11 interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent to be issued,
12 payable twenty years from date of issuance.
