STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section eighty-two of Chapter one hundred fifteen of the Revised Statutes of Nineteen Hundred Sixteen, relating to support of Debtors in Jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eighty-two of Chapter one hundred fifteen of the

- 2 Revised Statutes of Nineteen Hundred Sixteen is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out the words "two dollars and twenty-
- 4 five cents a week" in the second line of said section, and in-
- 5 serting in place thereof the words 'not less than fifty cents
- 6 a day' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-

'Sect. 82. In case of dispute about the price of such sup-2 port, the county commissioners may determine it, not ex-3 ceeding fifty cents a day.'
