STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 35, Section 12, Revised Statutes of 1916, relating to dairy, breeding and show cattle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter 35, Section 12, Revised Statutes of 1916, is amend-2 ed by striking out in the second line of said section the words 3 "state agricultural show" and inserting in place therefor 4 'agricultural show that receives aid or a stipend from the 5 state' and by striking out in the sixth line the word "state" 6 and inserting in place thereof the word 'any,' and further-7 more by adding in the second line the words 'oxen and

8 steers,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-9 lows:

'Sect. 12. Cattle used for dairy purposes or for breeding 2 purposes and oxen and steers, that are to be shown in com-3 petition for prizes, in any agricultural show that receives 4 aid or a stipend from the state, shall be tested with tuber-5 culin, within twelve months of the opening date of the ex-6 hibition where they are to be shown. Such test shall be 7 made under the direction of the live stock sanitary com-8 missioner, who shall furnish a certificate of such test, to the 9 owner or owners of such animals. Any agricultural asso-10 ciations that receive aid from the state shall demand a cer-11 tificate of test, duly authorized by the live stock sanitary 12 commissioner, from owners of cattle that are to compete 13 for prizes in accordance with the above, under penalty of 14 forfeiture of such aid; but this provision shall not apply 15 to calves less than six months old.'
