STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 82, Section 72, Revised Statutes of 1916, relating to appropriations for the employment by the Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 82, Section 72, is hereby amended by striking out
2 the word "fifteen" in the second line of said section, and
3 inserting in place therefor the words 'seventy-five' so that
4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 72. For said purpose the sum of seventy-five hun-
2 dred dollars shall be appropriated each year, and so much

3 thereof as may be necessary, may be expended under the
4 direction of the attorney general. The Governor and coun-
5 cil may draw their warrants from time to time, for the ex-
6 penditure of said sum, upon the presentation of bills pro-
7 perly avouched by the attorney general.'
