IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

---

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan  
Asylum for maintenance and other purposes for the years  
nineteen hundred seventeen and nineteen hundred eighteen.

---

*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for  
2 the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum:

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages of all  
2 officers and employees except those wholly engaged in re-  
3 pairs of buildings and equipment, for the year nineteen hun-  
4 dred seventeen, the sum of three thousand seven hundred  
5 and twenty-five (\$3,725.00) dollars, and for the year nine-

6 teen hundred eighteen, the sum of three thousand seven  
7 hundred and twenty-five (\$3,725.00) dollars.

For food supplies, namely, all articles of food, for the year  
2 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of four thousand five  
3 hundred (\$4,500.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hun-  
4 dred eighteen, the sum of four thousand five hundred  
5 (\$4,500.00) dollars.

For clothing, namely, all articles of personal clothing and  
2 materials for making the same, for the year nineteen hun-  
3 dred seventeen, the sum of one thousand one hundred and  
4 seventy-five (\$1,175.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen  
5 hundred eighteen, the sum of one thousand one hundred  
6 and seventy-five (\$1,175.00) dollars.

For repairs and equipment, namely, all materials and sup-  
2 plies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached  
3 fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replacements of  
4 furniture and equipment, including farm equipment and live-  
5 stock, and all personal services rendered wholly in connec-  
6 tion with repair work, for the year nineteen hundred seven-  
7 teen, the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, and for the  
8 year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of two thousand  
9 five hundred (\$2,500.00) dollars.

For general expenses, namely, all other materials, supplies  
2 and expenses incident to maintenance of the institution and  
3 the inmates thereof, whether present or absent, for the year  
4 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of two thousand eight  
5 hundred and twenty-five (\$2,825.00) dollars, and for the

6 year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of two thousand  
7 eight hundred and twenty-five (\$2,825.00) dollars.

*Provided*, that any balance of the sums above appropriated  
2 for the year nineteen hundred seventeen which may remain  
3 unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for ex-  
4 penditure during the year nineteen hundred eighteen, and  
5 provided further, that the Governor and Council may, by or-  
6 der, upon recommendation of the trustees of said institution,  
7 authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the above  
8 appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropriations  
9 for such institution.
