AN ACT to amend section two of chapter sixty-four of the  
Revised Statutes relating to marriage by insane or feeble-  
minded persons.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section two of chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "insane" and  
3 before the word "person" the words 'or feeble-minded,' so  
4 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. No insane or feeble-minded person or idiot is  
2 capable of contracting marriage.'
