STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one hundred seventy-two of chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred sixteen, relating to teachers' pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred seventy-two of chapter sixteen of the
2 Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred sixteen is hereby
3 amended by adding thereto the following words, 'until said
4 person shall have reached the age of eighty years, and after
5 said person shall have attained the age of eighty years they
6 shall receive the full sum of any amount designated under

7 the foregoing sections for the remainder of their life,' so
8 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 172. Teachers who may receive half pensions.
2 1913, c. 75, § 4. Any person who otherwise meets the re-
3 quirements of the three preceding sections, but shall have
4 retired or shall have been retired prior to the school year
5 next preceding the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hun-
6 dred thirteen, shall be entitled to receive a pension under
7 the provisions of this section and the three preceding sec-
8 tions, except that the amount of the pension allowed to such
9 person shall be one-half of any amount designated under
10 the foregoing sections until said person shall have reached
11 the age of eighty years, and after said person shall have
12 attained the age of eighty years they shall receive the full
13 sum of any amount designated under the foregoing sections
14 for the remainder of their life.'
