STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, appointing a Commission to investigate and report the advisability of making improvements in Portland Harbor; defining the duties of the Commissioners; and providing for the payment of their expenses.

Resolved: Section 1. That the Governor, with the advice 2 and consent of the Council, be, and he hereby is, authorized 3 and directed to appoint a Commission consisting of five per-4 sons, to investigate the condition of Portland Harbor, and 5 report to the next session of the Legislature its recommen-6 dations relative to the advisability of the State, or the City 7 of Portland, constructing and building into the tide waters 8 of said Harbor, a State or Municipal dock; and such fur-

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9 ther legislation respecting the control thereof, as said Com-10 mission may deem necessary and advisable for the public 11 interests.

Sect. 2. The members of the Commission hereby created, 2 shall serve without compensation.

Sect. 3. Said Commission shall not make, nor cause to be 2 made, any survey of the navigable waters of said Harbor, 3 unless, upon application to the Governor and Council, the 4 latter shall determine that the surveys made by the United 5 States, are not sufficient for the purposes herein contemplat-6 ed, and give directions for such further surveys to be made.
