STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the National Camps and Hotel Company to construct and maintain a wharf in Sebago Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The National Camps and Hotel Company, a

- 2 corporation duly established and existing under the laws of
- 3 this State, its successors or assigns, are hereby authorized
- 4 and empowered to construct and maintain a wharf in Sebago
- 5 Lake at South Casco, in the town of Casco, county of Cum-
- 6 berland, near said camps and hotel and to extend the same,
- 7 far enough into said lake to allow the landing of boats and
- 8 steamers.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
