HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to amend the extend the charter of the Bangor Boom  
Company

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Charter of the Bangor Boom Company,  
2 with all the rights and privileges and all the responsibilities  
3 attached to said company, by virtue of the several acts creat-  
4 ing, extending and relating thereto, shall continue and re-  
5 main in force for twenty years from March thirty-first, nine-  
6 teen hundred and eighteen, provided, however, that said com-  
7 pany shall receive as toll ten cents for each thousand feet,  
8 as is now provided; and also provided, however, that all

9 agreements now in force and in effect for payment by said  
10 Bangor Boom Company of annual rent or yearly damages  
11 to the proprietor or proprietors of shore or shores on the  
12 Penobscot River, shall cease on March thirty-first, nineteen  
13 hundred and eighteen, and thereafter all such agreements  
14 shall be of no legal force or effect; and also provided, how-  
15 ever, that said corporation shall thereafter pay to the pro-  
16 prietor or proprietors of shore or shores taken, used or occu-  
17 pied by said corporation, such annual rent or yearly dam-  
18 ages as may be agreed upon by the parties; and if said Ban-  
19 gor Boom Company and the proprietor or proprietors of  
20 shore or shores taken, used or occupied by said Bangor  
21 Boom Company cannot after March thirty-first, nineteen  
22 hundred and eighteen, agree on the annual rent or yearly  
23 damages to be thereafter paid by said Bangor Boom Com-  
24 pany to such proprietor or proprietors, of such shore or  
25 shores, then the proprietor or proprietors of such shore or  
26 shores may obtain such annual rent or yearly damages in  
27 the same mode and manner as is provided in Chapter 94 of  
28 the Revised Statutes of 1903, for damages where land is  
29 flowed by the erection of mills and dams.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the pro-  
2 visions of this act are hereby repealed.
