### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to extend and amend the Charter of the Eastern Maine Railroad.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The rights, powers and privileges of the East-2 ern Maine Railroad, which were granted by chapter one
hundred eighty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of the
4 State of Maine for the year nineteen hundred eleven, and
5 extended and amended by chapter eighty-six of the Private
6 and Special Laws of the State of Maine, for the year nine7 teen hundred thirteen, and which were further extended by
8 chapter three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen

9 hundred fifteen, are hereby extended for two years addition-10 al, and the persons named in said act and their associates and 11 successors shall have the rights, powers and privileges that 12 were granted to them by said act and the amendments there-13 of, to be exercised by them for the same purposes as specified 14 in said act and the amendments thereof.

Sect. 2. Said Railroad is hereby authorized, upon compli-2 ance with section 6 of chapter fifty-six of the Revised Stat-3 utes of nineteen hundred sixteen, so far as applicable to this 4 act, to extend its lines from some point on its present loca-5 tion in Orient, or in Weston, in a general easterly or north-6 easterly direction, to the eastern boundary of the state, with 7 all the rights and privileges so far as this extension is con-8 cerned, and subject to all the conditions, provisions and limi-9 tations contained in the original act, under which this road 10 was incorporated, and amendments thereto.

Sect. 3. All rights herein granted are on the express con-2 dition that said Eastern Maine Railroad shall, on or before 3 the expiration of two years, have graded, ready for rails and 4 sleepers, at least thirty miles of its road-bed, and if this con-5 dition is not complied with, this act shall not confer any 6 further rights after said two years.
