STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Authorize and Direct the County Commissioners of Aroostook County to Enlarge and Repair the Court House at Caribou in said County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The County Commissioners of Aroostook County are
2 hereby authorized and directed to proceed forthwith
3 to expend so much as shall be needed, not to exceed
4 in all the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars in enlarging
5 and repairing the court house in Caribou in said county,
6 enlarging and remodelling the various rooms and apart-

7 ments, and to obtain a loan or loans for such purpose and
8 for said amount, and cause notes or obligations of said
9 county with coupons for interest and a rate not to exceed
10 six per cent to be issued, payable ten to fifteen years from
11 date of issuance.
