STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section twelve of chapter forty-three of the Private and Special Laws, eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, entitled "An Act to Establish the Rumford Falls Municipal Court."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The word "one" in the fifth line of section twelve of chapter forty-three of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred ninety-nine is hereby stricken out and the word 'two' is substituted, so that said section, as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 12. Costs and fees allowed to parties and attor-

2 neys in all actions before said court, in which the debt or
3 damages recovered does not exceed twenty dollars, shall
4 be the same as are allowed in actions before trial justices,
5 except that the plaintiff if he prevail shall be allowed two
6 dollars for his writ, and the defendant if he prevail one
7 dollar for his pleadings; but in cases where the damages
8 do exceed twenty dollars, the fees and costs shall be the
9 same as in the supreme judicial court.'
