IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in Favor of Several Academies, Institutes, Sem-  
inaries and Colleges for Maintenance and for Repairs and  
Improvements.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated in  
2 favor of the academies, institutes, seminaries and colleges  
3 hereinafter listed the sum of thirteen thousand one hundred  
4 dollars for the year nineteen hundred seventeen, and the  
5 sum of eleven thousand eight hundred fifty dollars for the  
6 year nineteen hundred eighteen, said sums to be expended  
7 under the direction of the board of trustees of said insti-  
8 tutions to the amount and for the purposes indicated in the  
9 following schedule.

For the year nineteen hundred seventeen :

Hartland Academy, Hartland, for repairs on academy  
2 building and equipment for same, one thousand dollars.

Erskine Academy, South China, for repairs on school  
2 building, laboratory equipment, and instruction in course in  
3 agriculture, seven hundred fifty dollars.

Freedom Academy, Freedom, for meeting deficiency and  
2 current expenses, and for making urgent repairs, five hun-  
3 dred dollars.

Monmouth Academy, Monmouth, for repairing and remod-  
2 eling the main school building, five hundred dollars.

Lee Academy, Lee, for the payment of instructors, five  
2 hundred dollars.

Eastern Maine Institute, Springfield, for finishing and  
2 equipping school building, seven hundred fifty dollars.

Eastern Maine Institute, Springfield, for reimbursement  
2 under general academy law for nineteen hundred sixteen,  
3 five hundred dollars.

Saint Joseph's Academy, Portland, for maintenance, one  
2 thousand dollars.

Van Buren College, Van Buren, for maintenance and  
2 equipment, five hundred dollars.

Ricker Classical Institute, Houlton, for repair and im-  
2 provement of buildings and fixtures, five hundred dollars.

North Yarmouth Academy, North Yarmouth, for repair  
2 and improvement of buildings, and improvement of grounds,  
3 five hundred dollars.

2 hundred dollars.

2 teacher training course, five hundred dollars.

2 dred dollars.

3 thousand dollars.

2 poses, one thousand dollars.
