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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to amend Section one hundred ten of Chapter Sixteen  
of the Revised Statutes, relating to teachers' associations.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section one hundred ten of chapter sixteen of the Revised  
2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting the words 'five hun-  
3 dred' after the word "thousand" in the tenth line thereof and  
4 by striking out all of said section following the word "state"  
5 in the twelfth line thereof so that said section when amended  
6 shall read as follows:

'Whenever not less than thirty of the teachers and school  
2 officers of any county shall have formed an association under

3 rules of government approved by the state superintendent of  
4 public schools, for the purpose of mutual improvement in the  
5 science and art of teaching, and of creating popular interest  
6 in, and diffusing a knowledge of the best methods of improv-  
7 ing our public school system, by the holding of conventions  
8 at least once every year under the supervision of the state  
9 superintendent, the state shall defray the necessary expenses  
10 attending the holding of such conventions, for which purpose  
11 the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars is hereby an-  
12 nually appropriated to be deducted and set aside therefor by  
13 the treasurer of state from the annual school fund of the  
14 state.'
