STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT Relating to the May Term of the Supreme Judicial
Court in the County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The May term of the supreme judicial court within and
2 for the county of Oxford shall be held at Rumford on the
3 second Tuesday of May in each year. Said May term shall
4 hereafter be held with a grand jury. The March term of
5 said supreme judicial court within and for said county shall
6 be held at Paris on the second Tuesday of March in each
7 year. Said March term shall be held without a grand jury
8 unless specially ordered by any judge of said court. All

9 recognizances and other criminal processes made returnable
10 to and to have day in said March term, when no criminal
11 business is transacted, shall be continued to and have day
12 in the next term of said court held in said county.
