STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section fifteen of chapter ten of the Revised Statutes of 1916 relating to the taxing of toll bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen of chapter ten of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following is substituted in the place thereof.

‘Sect. 15. Toll bridges, toll houses and the land appurtenant thereto shall be taxed as real estate in the town or towns where situated; and where such bridge is in two towns, one half of the toll bridge shall be assessed and taxed in each town.’
