STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter fifty-three of the Revised Stat-
utes of 1916 relating to the payment of benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No corporation organized or authorized under the laws
2 of this State to transact life insurance or to pay benefits
3 shall provide in any policy, certificate, contract, or agree-
4 ment issued or made by it, for the payment of any insur-
5 ance, indemnity, or benefit, in services, goods, wares, or
6 merchandise of any kind, or in any other thing except
7 money.
