STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT authorizing Fort Kent Electric Company, its successors and assigns, to erect and maintain a dam across Wallagrass Stream in Wallagrass Plantation at its power station as now located on said Wallagrass Stream.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Fort Kent Electric Company, a corporation
2 organized by law and located at Fort Kent in the county of
3 Aroostook and State of Maine, is hereby authorized to erect,
4 construct and maintain a dam across Wallagrass Stream in
5 Wallagrass Plantation, in said county of Aroostook, at or
6 near its power plant as now located on said Wallagrass
7 Stream, or maintain the dam of said Electric Company al-

8 ready erected, for the purpose of furnishing water power to 9 be used for any of the purposes for which said Fort Kent 10 Electric Company is organized.

Sect. 2. For the aforesaid purposes said company may 2 raise and maintain said dam to such height, not exceeding 3 thirty feet, as shall enable it at all times to obtain a suffi-4 cient head of water on said Wallagrass Stream for the prop-5 er and efficient operation of its said power plant.

Sect. 3. Said company shall construct and maintain prop-2 er and suitable sluiceways to allow the free passage of logs, 3 lumber and pulp wood, which sluiceways shall be at the dis-4 posal of all persons driving said stream without any charge 5 for tolls, provided that at all times said company shall have 6 the right to refuse to permit the use of said sluiceways when 7 the flow of water in said stream is such that the use of said 8 sluiceways will prevent said company from holding a suffi-9 cient head of water for the proper operation of its said pow-10 er plant, provided, nevertheless, that said corporation shall 11 on demand at any time allow any person driving said stream 12 a run of water equal to the natural flow thereof.

Sect. 4. All persons damaged in their property rights by 2 reason of the rights granted said company by this act shall 3 be entitled to have their damages assessed in the same man-4 ner as is provided by law for the assessment of damages for 5 the laying out of highways.
