STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT authorizing the American Realty Company to erect
and maintain piers and booms in the St. John River in the
Plantation of St. John and the Plantation of St. Francis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The American Realty Company, a corporation
2 organized under the laws of the State of Maine, its suc-
3 cessors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered
4 to erect and maintain piers and booms in the St. John River
5 in the Plantation of St. John and the Plantation of St. Fran-
6 cis at a point near the lower end of Powers Island and ex-
7 tending up the river to a point next to the International
8 boundary line opposite the St. John Station of the Bangor

9 & Aroostook Railroad, and thence up said river to a point
10 near the Ward & Bradbury mill in the Plantation of St.
11 Francis, for the purpose of sorting and holding their logs
12 and lumber.

Sect. 2. All piers and booms authorized by this act shall
2 be erected and maintained in such a manner as not to im-
3 pede navigation or unreasonably obstruct the common use
4 of the river, especially not to hinder or delay the driving of
5 logs and lumber at all times. All stray logs and lumber that
6 may gather in said booms shall be turned out by the party
7 or parties owning or operating the same at their own expense
8 immediately upon the request of the owner.
