STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section four of Chapter seventy-six of the Revised Statutes, relating to notices upon petitions for sale of real estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of Chapter seventy-six of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "cause" in the fifth line of said section, the following words: 'But such notice, when public, may be published in a consolidated form, and shall contain the name of the estate or the title of the case, the name of the petitioner and the name of

7 the city, town, or plantation where such real estate is situ-
8 ated; but such notice need contain no other description of
9 the real estate,' so that said section as amended shall read
10 as follows:

'Sect. 4. No license shall be granted for the sale of any
2 such real estate, of the value of more than fifty dollars, un-
3 less by written consent of all persons interested therein, un-
4 til after public or personal notice of the time and place of
5 hearing, to all such persons, to appear and object if they
6 see cause; but such notice, when public, may be published
7 in a consolidated form, and shall contain the name of the
8 estate or the title of the case, the names of the petitioner
9 and the name of the city, town, or plantation where such
10 real estate is situated; but such notice need contain no other
11 description of the real estate. If any party interested resides
12 without the state, or the real estate is situated in a county
13 other than the county in which the proceedings are pending,
14 such special notice may be given as the court directs.'
