STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section twenty-six of Chapter Twenty-five of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred sixteen, relating to patrol maintenance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section twenty-six of chapter twenty-five of the Revised

- 2 Statutes of Nineteen Hundred Sixteen is hereby amended
- 3 by adding thereto the following: 'but acceptance of the
- 4 provisions of this section shall be optional with the towns
- 5 in which said state or state aid highways are located,' so
- 6 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 26. Every town in which the State Highway Com2 mission, acting under the provisions of section nine, or sec3 tion eighteen of chapter one hundred thirty, of the Public
4 Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, supervises the mainten5 ance of any state or state aid highway is hereby directed to
6 cooperate with the said State Highway Commission in the
7 employment of a regular road patrolman to perform main8 tenance work in addition to that upon the state highway or
9 the state aid highway, upon such mileage of road as shall be
10 mutually agreed upon by the municipal officers of the town
11 and the State Highway Commission, but acceptance of the
12 provisions of this section shall be optional with the towns in
13 which said state or state aid highways are located.'
