STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to provide compensation for injuries received by state
employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

All persons employed by the state or under the direction
2 and control of any department of the state shall be entitled
3 to the benefits of chapter fifty of the Revised Statutes and
4 upon petition of such employee or his representative filed
5 within three years after receiving injury, the industrial acci-
6 dent commission shall assess the amount of compensation

7 due in accordance with the provisions of said chapter. The
8 governor and council shall order such compensation so as-
9 sessed paid from the state contingent fund.
