AN ACT to amend Chapter 121 of the Private and Special Laws of 1913, to enable the annual meetings of Madison Water District to be held at any time during the month of July in each year.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 17 of Chapter 121 of the Private and Special Laws of 1913 is hereby amended by striking out in the second and third lines of said section the words, "on the first Monday of July," and inserting in the place thereof, 'during the month of July,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows: ·

'Sect. 17. The annual meetings of said water district and the respective sections thereof shall be held during the month

3 of July in each year after the acceptance of this act for the  
4 choice of one or more trustees and such other officers as said  
5 water district or sections thereof shall by vote or by-laws  
6 determine, and for the transaction of any other business that  
7 may legally come before such meetings; special meetings of  
8 said water district and of the respective sections thereof shall  
9 be called at any time upon written application to the assessors  
10 of Madison Village Corporation and the selectmen of Anson  
11 respectively by the trustees or ten or more legal voters of  
12 said water district or of the respective sections thereof. The  
13 written application for such meetings shall contain in separate  
14 articles the business to be acted on and no other business shall  
15 be transacted at said meeting except such as is contained in  
16 the articles of the warrant calling such special meetings. All  
17 meetings, except the first, of said water district and of the  
18 respective sections thereof may be held jointly or separately  
19 as said sections may by vote or by-law determine.'
