STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to prevent officers and employees of banking institu-
tions from making copies of records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any officer or employee of any savings bank, institution for
2 savings, trust company, loan company, or loan and building
3 association, making copies of any of the books, papers, rec-
4 ords or documents belonging to or in the custody of any of
5 the before named institutions, either for his own use or for
6 the use of any other person other than in the ordinary and
7 regular course of his duties as such officer or employee, shall
8 be subject to a penalty of a fine not exceeding five hundred
9 dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding one year or by both
10 such fine and imprisonment.
