STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to enable the register of deeds of Cumberland county to procure durable copies of plans recorded in said registry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The register of deeds for the county of Cumberland is

hereby authorized and empowered to cause to be made,

durable copies of the plans, including any and all blue
prints, recorded in the Cumberland county register of deeds.

The copies shall be upon such scale and in such form as will

comply with the requirements of section sixteen of chapter

twelve of the revised statutes. The said register may also

procure and record a copy of Day's plan of South Portland

9 in said county, made by I. C. Sours in 1863. The said reg10 ister of deeds shall compare carefully, the copies authorized
11 hereby with the plans now recorded in said registry and
12 shall certify on each copy the fact of such comparison and
13 such certified copies shall stand for, and in place of the
14 plans and blueprints now recorded. It shall be the duty
15 of the said register and his successors, to preserve in said
16 registry, the said original plans now recorded and to exhibit
17 the same to persons interested.

The treasurer of Cumberland county is hereby authorized 2 and directed to pay a sum not exceeding two thousand five 3 hundred dollars for the purpose of carrying out the require-4 ments of this act, upon itemized vouchers submitted and 5 signed by said register.
