STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 51 of chapter 82 of the Revised Statutes providing for order of trial at Supreme Judicial Court for Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-one of Chapter eighty-two of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding to the third paragraph thereof, the following words, 'At each term of which the Court shall hear and try only such civil actions pending in said court as may be more conveniently tried at that term, except that by agreement of attorneys interested

7 other cases may be placed upon such trial list,' so that said
8 third paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Aroostook, at Houlton, on the third Tuesdays of April
2 and November, for civil and criminal business, and at Car-
3 ibou on the first Tuesdays of February and September for
4 civil business only; at each term of which the Court shall
5 hear and try only such civil actions pending in said court
6 as may be more conveniently tried at that term, except that
7 by agreement of attorneys interested other cases may be
8 placed upon such trial list:—'
