STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the erection and maintenance of a bridge
across that part of the Aroostook River known as the Back
Channel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

George B. Smith of Ashland in the County of Aroostook,
2 his heirs and assigns, are hereby authorized to erect and
3 maintain a bridge suitable for farm traffic across that part of
4 the Aroostook River known as the Back Channel, at the
5 westerly terminal of the Goding Road, so called, in said Ash-
6 land, to the Bearce and Butler islands, so called, in said
7 Aroostook River, in the Town of Ashland.
