STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, making appropriation for support of Bureau of Weights and Measures for years 1917 and 1918.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the year nineteen 3 hundred seventeen and the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, to be expended by the Commissioner of Agriculture, as Sealer of 5 Weights and Measures, to carry out the provisions of chap-6 ter eighty-two of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred 7 eleven.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is to provide for the work of the Bureau of Weights and Measures for the years 1917 and 1918. The sum is \$500 less than that made for the years 1913 and 1914 and \$500 more than that made for the years 1915 and 1916.

Owing to the fact that there will be more work done in this office than there was in 1915 and 1916, as there were about one hundred and fifty towns which did no work, and we shall be obliged to specially visit these places as well as all others, so our traveling expenses will be larger; also in 1918 we have a large amount of extra work to do in testing all weights and measures in the State and our expenses in that mater will be somewhat larger
