AN ACT to amend Chapter 117, Section 18, of the Revised  
Statutes of 1916 relating to the Insurance Department.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Chapter 117, Section 18, of the Revised Statutes of 1916,  
2 is amended by adding after the word "dollars" in the second  
3 line thereof, the words 'in full payment for all services, both  
4 as insurance commissioner and as a member of the Industrial  
5 Accident Commission' so that, said section, as amended,  
6 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 18. The insurance commissioner shall receive an  
2 annual salary of two thousand five hundred dollars in full

3 payment for all services, both as insurance commissioner  
4 and as a member of the Industrial Accident Commission.

‘The deputy insurance commissioner shall receive an an-  
2 nual salary of eighteen hundred dollars.

‘The Governor and Council may allow such reasonable  
2 sums for postage, clerk hire, and actual expenses incurred in  
3 the proper enforcement of the laws relating to insurance  
4 as they deem proper.’
