IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to authorize The American Thread Company to erect
a bridge across Sebec river in the town of Milo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The American Thread Company, its successors and as-
2 signs, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a bridge
3 suitable for traffic with teams and loghauler appliances,
4 across Sebec river in the town of Milo, at a point between
5 the railway bridge in Milo village and the mouth of Stod-
6 dard brook; said bridge to be so constructed that the center
7 span will be not less than one hundred feet in length.
