STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section thirty-six of Chapter fifty-eight of
the Revised Statutes, Relating to Discontinuance of Street
Railroad Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-six of chapter fifty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "portion of the winter months," in the fourth and fifth lines of said section, and inserting in place thereof the word 'time' and by inserting after the word "corporation" in the sixth line of said section, the words, 'or any ten voters of the town' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 36. Upon a written application by any street rail-
2 road corporation, to the municipal officers of any city or
3 town, and hearing thereon, the municipal officers may au-
4 thorize said corporation to discontinue the running of its
5 cars during such time, and upon such terms and conditions
6 as they may determine; said corporation or any ten voters of
7 the town may appeal from such decision to the public utilities
8 commission, who shall after reasonable notice and hearing,
9 make such a determination thereon as shall be reasonable and
10 proper, and their decision shall be final.’
