STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT fixing the salary of the recorder of the Old Town
Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter three hundred and eighty-four of
2 the private and special laws of the year nineteen hundred
3 and seven is hereby amended by substituting the word 'five'
4 for the word "four" in the second line of said section; and
5 by adding to said section the following words, 'said record-
6 er by virtue of his said office shall be a justice of the peace
7 for each of our several counties,' so that said section when
8 so amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. The salary of the recorder of said court is here-
2 by fixed at five hundred dollars, annually, to be paid quar-
3 terly from the treasury of Penobscot county. Said recorder
4 by virtue of his said office shall be a justice of the peace
5 for each of our several counties.'
