STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Regulate the Operation of Jitney Busses, or Any
Other Steam or Motor Driven Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The state highway commission may, upon

2 proper application in writing, grant permits for the operation

3 of jitney busses, so-called, or any other steam or motor

4 vehicles making regular schedule trips for the carriage of

5 passengers or freight from one point to another, over any

6 street, highway, or bridge, and may make regulations limit-

7 ing the rate of speed of such vehicles, their weight, the load

8 they may carry, and the time of year during which they may

9 operate, and any other regulations which in the opinion of 10 said commission are necessary for the protection of said 11 streets or highways, and no such jitney bus, or other steam 12 or motor driven vehicles shall be so operated on any highway 13 or town way without such permit.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act shall be liable to the penalty provided by section four-3 teen of chapter twenty-six of the Revised Statutes, except 4 that in the case of damage to any street, highway or bridge, 5 any fine shall be paid into the state treasury and shall be 6 used for the repair of the street, highway or bridge so 7 damaged.
