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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to amend Chapter Nine, Section Thirty-Three of the  
Revised Statutes of Nineteen Sixteen, Relating to Taxation  
of Owners of Parlor Cars.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Chapter, nine section thirty-three of the revised statutes  
2 of nineteen hundred sixteen, is hereby amended by striking  
3 out the word "six" in the fifth line of said section, and  
4 inserting in place thereof the word 'nine' so that said section  
5 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 33. Every corporation or person owning or operat-  
2 ing parlor or other cars for which extra compensation is

3 charged for riding therein over any of the railroads of the  
4 state shall annually on the first day of September, pay to  
5 the treasurer of state for the use of the state an annual  
6 excise tax for the privilege of exercising its franchises in  
7 the state, equal to nine per cent of its or his gross receipts  
8 from business done wholly in this state, for the year ending  
9 June thirtieth next preceding.'
